- 1. The meeting minutes from 11/11/2011 were approved.
- 2. Science Area Chair Committee (SACC):
- A. A&S will not be reorganized into two colleges. The search for a new Dean of the College will start soon.
- B. The next round of Faculty recruitment happens in May, but the department is not part of that round.
- C. Waivers: The University gives the Dean's office a fixed budget to use for waivers; the Dean's office then splits that money among all departments.
- 3. Expo: The expo will need to be between April 5 –April 15. The purpose of the Expo is to let the University know why Scientific Computing is important and expose the work of our student.
